MFA in English Recommended Timeline

First Year

Fall

ENGL 6480 (recommended but not required) + workshop + one additional ENGL course (9 credit hours) WRTG 7480 (for students teaching WRTG 2010) Consult with DGS regarding spring courses

Spring

Workshop + two additional ENGL courses (9 credit hours) Select committee chair and form supervisory committee

Note:

MFA students must take ENGL 7450 or 7460, which are only offered in alternate years

Second Year

<u>Fall</u> Workshop + one additional ENGL course ENGL 6970 (Thesis Research) Consult Graduate Advisor about applying for graduation

Spring

Workshop + one additional ENGL course or ENGL 7450 or 7460 (if not taken in the first year) ENGL 6970 (Thesis Research) Submit and defend thesis

Note:

Funded students must register for 9 credit hours each semester to qualify for the tuition benefit program. ENGL 6980 (Faculty Consultation) should be taken to make up the deficit in any semester in which a student is registered for fewer than 9 credit hours.
